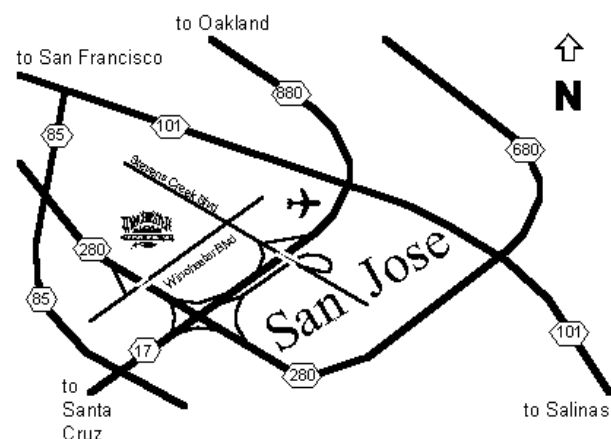

Guided Tours daily of rifle heiress Sarah Winchester's **160-room Victorian mansion**. California's largest turn of the century Victorian mansion was under construction 24-hours a day for 38 years, from 1884-1922. Built as a monument to appease the spirits of those killed by the Winchester rifle, the house contains **beautiful Tiffany art glass windows** and imported woods from around the world. The 24,000 square foot home had modern heating and sewer systems, gaslights, three working elevators and 47 fireplaces! Your group will marvel at **bizarre building oddities** such as doors opening onto walls, doors leading nowhere and staircases leading to the ceiling. Restoration continues in the mansion as well as in the acres of gardens surrounding it. Winchester House is **California State Historical Landmark #868** and is home to the West Coast's largest collection of Winchester Firearms. The Winchester Antique Products Museum, Gift Shoppe and Café are also open daily.
